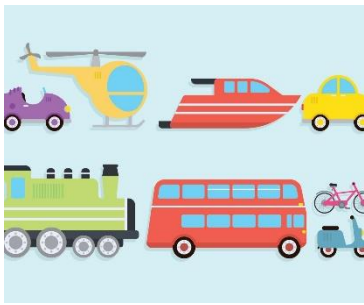




Bluebells Class Home Learning Topic Term 1 Transport and Journeys

ENGLISH

This term in Bluebells we will be learning about Transport and Journeys. We will begin by sharing a range of fictional text and our first story will be 'The Journey home from Grandpas'. We will use a range of strategies to support our learning which will include PECs and SCERTS that support our communication, word building and sentence construction. We will have daily group phonic sessions as well as individual phonics interventions. We will work on our fine motor skills through a range of interventions such as Write dance and Clever Fingers

Suggested Learning Support Activities

- Use the internet to find information about different types of transport
- Watch 'The Journey home from Grandpas' on Youtube
- Encourage your child to write and hold pens, pencils and crayons.
- Encourage your child to engage with books
- Encourage your child to identify the sounds in words associated with transport, for example, "what sound does the word bus begin with"

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on:

- Number
- Counting

Suggested Learning Support Activities

- Encourage your child to count, order, match and write numbers accurately.
- Play board games and encourage your child to look at the number on the dice and count as they move along the board.
- Count different items in your house (teddies, pillows, spoons etc).
- Encourage your child to add 1 digit numbers together to find out the amount. They could use a range of toy cars to help with this
