



Remote Learning

We are conscious of the continuing impact of lockdown for individual pupils and aim to support them to maintain their confidence as learners while they may need to take further time out of school due to both the pandemic and non-pandemic related reasons.

Through the delivery of remote learning via the learning platforms Seesaw (Years 1 – 14) and Tapestry for Early Years Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception), pupils who are out of school can access learning activities that have been uploaded by their class teacher.

The learning activities will be linked to the class termly topic or project, found on the class webpage and promote the learning of English and Maths skills alongside other areas, all of which are in-line with our Recovery Curriculum.
