Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Important Information

We are aware that there has been conflict in and around the car park and outside of Meadowfield School between parents/carers.

The school has been requested to become involved in order to resolve some of the disputes that have arisen, however, we are not party to the initial conflict and therefore we are receiving 'hearsay and he said, she said'. As these disputes are as a result of circumstances that have occurred in parents/carers personal lives, we would like to make very clear the position of the school;

School will not become involved, in any way, with any conflict between parents/carers. Our expectation is that all parents behave in an appropriate way on school grounds at all times, and this includes the car park. Please remember that our car park is private and should unsuitable behaviour take place, there is a risk that parents could be banned, either temporarily or permanently, from using the car park. Where there is conflict between a number of parents/carers we cannot take sides and we will therefore ban all parties.

Likewise, school will not become involved in any disputes outside of the school gates.

Should you ever feel threatened you may wish to ring Kent Police.

Our staff are employed to lead the school, educate and care for pupils and a large amount of time has been spent with these disputes, which we will no longer respond to. We hope this makes the position of the school clear and that we can move forward positively, being good examples for the pupils of Meadowfield School.
