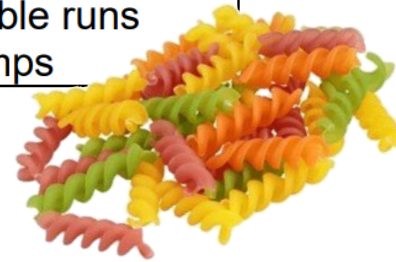

## Some examples of structured activities

- Mr Potato Head
